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Ardoch is an education charity focused on improving educational outcomes for children and young people in disadvantaged communities. We believe that every child's potential should be realised through full participation in education. This belief inspires us to increase engagement in education, build aspiration and enhance learning

outcomes of children in disadvantaged communities.


Ardoch has worked for more than 30 years to build the capacity of secondary and primary schools, early year's services and communities. Our literacy, STEM (science, technology, engineering and maths) and broadening horizons programs provide children in disadvantaged communities with access to positive working adult role models and real-world learning experiences that would not otherwise be available to them. We mobilise community and workplace volunteers to support schools and early childhood services also advocate for and seek to influence policy change to reduce inequity in education.



In 2019, Ardoch partnered with 135 primary schools, secondary schools and early learning centres, mobilised 1,773 volunteers who gave over 35,300 hours of their time, delivered more than 30,500 program participations and supported the education of 18,715 children and young people living in disadvantaged communities around Australia.

With a team of less than 20 paid staff and an annual turnover of \$2.5M cash revenue, we have significant impact through our award-winning programs.

What will my fundraising achieve?

Your fundraising can have a direct impact on the lives of children experiencing disadvantage. Here are some examples of how your fundraising can make a difference.


- Would place **5 Community Education Volunteers** in a school. Through the involvement of volunteers, students receive 1-on-1 or small group support with targeted reading, writing and language exercises and other areas of the curriculum and are able to build relationships with a trained and positive adult role model.
- **\$2,500** Would support **2 Robotics Tech Boxes** kits, filled with robotics resources. Robotics will not only enable students to apply their STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Maths) learning, but also help them to see its purpose and engage more with education. We also provide professional development to support teachers to deliver the program.
- \$1,000 Mock Interviews and Speed Careers sessions for 50 students.

 Pathways Beyond School provide students in areas of high disadvantage with unique and engaging learning and life experiences designed to support young people in preparation for employment, and increase aspiration towards continued education and training.

HOW TO FUNDRAISE FOR ARDOCH



Pick the type of event or activity you would like to organize to raise money on behalf of Ardoch



Review Ardoch's fundraising toolkit and guidelines to ensure that you understand your responsibilities as a fundraiser for Ardoch.



Complete the Authority to Fundraise application form & send it to info@ardoch.org.au



If your proposed idea is approved, we will provide a Letter of Authority to Fundraise & some support materials to help you start fundraising.



Organise and hold your activity. You are required to have fun during this step too!



HOW ARDOCH CAN HELP YOU

Set up a tailored website through which donations can be put via card and paypal.

Provide Ardoch promotional resources for your event, including fliers, posters, logos, coin collection tins and signage.

Publicity templates and tips. Promoting your event via social media and on Ardoch's website.

Providing tax receipts for donors (as per Fundraising Guidelines).

Attending your event to share the Ardoch story so your guests get to see how much the donations will help.

Lucia's 50th Birthday Soiree

In lieu of gifts for her 50th birthday soiree, Lucia, asked her friends and family to donate to Ardoch. Inspired by Ardoch's work with children, particularly the issue of child and youth literacy, Lucia raised over \$3000 on the night. Lucia's fundraiser was a hit and demonstrates the power of fundraising with family and friends on special occasions such as a birthday.



Giselle's Swimathon



Will & Nicky's Wedding

As a child, Will was a benefactor of Ardoch's work in his local community. Fifteen years later, Will and his fiancé Nicky decided to ask their wedding guests to donate to Ardoch in lieu of a lift to them. This kind gesture spoke volumes about the power and longevity of Ardoch's work.

Ultimately, their kind gesture raised over \$1000 for Ardoch.

As part of a school incentive, 12 year old Giselle swam 4km to raise \$1,400. "Each lap I did was a certain amount of money I could raise for Ardoch. Instead of people giving money for my Bat Mitzvah, it went into my fundraising page" explained the young swimmer.



SCHOOL GROUPS



24 Hour Row

Caulfield Grammar School students organised a 24-hour Rowing event at their school. Students took it in turns on the rowing machines, covering a full 24-hour period to raise funds that will improve the educational outcomes for children from disadvantaged communities.

This was an entirely student-led event with over 40 students competing. The students raised \$8,888 through this event.

Annual Trivia Night

The Caulfield Grammar community also organise an annual Trivia Night, raising between \$9,000 - \$10,000 each year.

Caulfield Grammar's initiatives are a great example of how everyone in the community can get involved in raising awareness about the impact of disadvantage on educational attainment, and the practical support for Ardoch's programs that is possible as a result of the school community's fundraising effort.





COMMUNITY GROUPS

Malvern Marlins Masters Swimming Club - Annual Swim Meet

The Malvern Marlins have been passionate supporters of Ardoch's work for over seven years. Based at the Harold Holt Swim Centre in Glen Iris, the Marlins currently have over 150 members and put on a fundraiser, selling raffle tickets at their annual swim meet. These funds raised provide disadvantaged children with swimming lessons in the city of Stonnington.

In addition to the donation of goggles and swimwear in the early years of their support, they have fundraised over \$9000 for Ardoch's programs.





Wilson Storage Southern Saints Netball Club

The Saints have been strong supporters of Ardoch's work fundraising by way of door sales and tin-rattling on match day. The Saints and their community raised over \$500 at their meet last year.

PHYSICAL CHALLENGES

ARDOCH FUNDRAISING GUIDELINES

In order to comply with State and Territory legislation, Ardoch must approve and authorise all third-party fundraising activities that directly raise money for Ardoch. Each application will be assessed to ensure compliance with the organisation's standards of conduct.

Ardoch Fundraising Guidelines

- 1. All constituent details of the approved fundraising activity are the sole responsibility of the applicant, as set out in the Authority to Fundraise form.
- 2. The organiser must comply with obligations imposed by the Charitable Fundraising Act and applicable State/Territory laws and regulations.
- 3. All relevant permits and licenses for the activity must be secured by the event organiser.
- 4. Any and all promotional material and collateral produced in conjunction with the proposed fundraising activity must clearly state that this event is 'raising funds for Ardoch', as opposed to an Ardoch Limited-managed event.
- 5. Any use of Ardoch's logo is to be approved prior to publication by an authorised representative of Ardoch Limited.
- 6. Ardoch alone is authorised to issue a tax- deductable receipt for funds raised and donated to Ardoch Limited. Please note that the Australian Tax Office has ruled that donations are not tax deductable if the donation involves the exchange of money for goods and/or services such as raffle tickets, competition or event entry tickets. In order to comply with State and Territory legislation, Ardoch must approve and authorise all third-party fundraising activities that directly raise money for Ardoch. Each application will be assessed to ensure compliance with the organisation's standards of conduct.
- 7. A detailed income and expenditure form must be filled out and accompany any donation.
- 8. Funds raised must be reconciled with Ardoch no later than 10 working days after the event or activity.
- 9. Funds raised can be deposited directly into Ardoch Ltd bank account, mailed in as a cheque, or donated via the application on our website.

11. Ardoch is unable to provide insurance of any kind, including public liability, for your event. Ardoch cannot be held responsible for any accident or injury sustained over the course of your event Ardoch reserves the right to refuse or cancel the Authority to Fundraise if it is decided the activity is not in the best interests of the organisation.
