



Making a bequest gift to Ardoch Youth Foundation

It is important to seek legal advice in making or updating your Will, from a solicitor, State or Public Trustee or Trustee Company.

The suggested forms of wording below are provided for your assistance in discussing a bequest to Ardoch with your legal advisor.

I GIVE, FREE OF ALL DEBTS (SECURED AND UNSECURED), DUTIES AND TAXES (FEDERAL OR STATE)

the whole of my estate, OR
