Education Volunteers commit to attend weekly for two hours for at least six months to the partner site they are matched to.			
	In a school setting, volunteers usually work one-on-one with a student or a group of students who need extra help with their literacy skills, however depending on the needs of our education partners, volunteers may also support a range of other in-class activities.
