Ardoch is committed to protecting children's rights, safety and wellbeing and has a zero-tolerance approach to all forms of child abuse.

Note: NSW Working with Children Checks can take <u>up to 4 weeks</u> to be processed by the Department of Justice.

Apply as soon as possible

Already have a Working with Children Check?

- 1. Complete the Ardoch volunteer application form (and provide your WWC check number, expiry date and date of birth as part of the form).
 - You can retrieve your Working with Children Check number here.
- 2. Ardoch will verify your check and no further action is needed by you

If you do not have a Working with Children Check

You will need to apply for a Working with Children Check online and then prove your identity at a Service NSW Centre. Information on how to apply can be found here.

Please read the <u>proof of identity documents requirements</u> carefully, to ensure you have what you need. You do not need to be an Australian citizen to apply; you just need to be able to prove your identity. Once you have the appropriate proof of identity documents, follow the steps below.

- 1. Visit the Working with Children Check NSW website and click 'apply'
- 2. When asked for the 'purpose of your check' please select 'Volunteer'.
- 3. When asked for the 'child related sector' you will be working in please select 'Education'.
- 4. Once you have completed the application form, you need to **prove your identity** at a Service NSW Centre with your email receipt to finalise your application within 28 days.

- 5. After you have received your WWCC, please email compliance@ardoch.org.au with your WWC number, so that we can verify your card.
