ABOUT NUMERACY BUDDIES

Ardoch's Numeracy Buddies program works with schools to help children develop maths skills through an online blog. We pair students with adult mentors who volunteer their time to solve maths problems over the course of the year. This helps students improve their numeracy and grow in confidence.

Numeracy Buddies includes:

- Exciting online blog challenges throughout the year
- One buddy meet-up at your child's school
- One excursion to the Big Buddies' workplace

This program not only helps improve your child's understanding of maths, but also gets them thinking about their futures as they learn about different careers from successful working role models.

Child safety

Everything we do at Ardoch is about improving the lives of children. A commitment to child safety is central to Ardoch's purpose and values.

As a child safe organisation we will:

- Screen every blog according to our child safety rules – there is no unmonitored communication between the Buddies in the program.
- Ensure all Ardoch staff and volunteers have a working with children check and a police check, sign a Code of Conduct, undertake child safety training and follow our Child Safety Policy.
- Only allow volunteers who are screened and trained by Ardoch to be involved in the visits.
