3.14159...

Pi

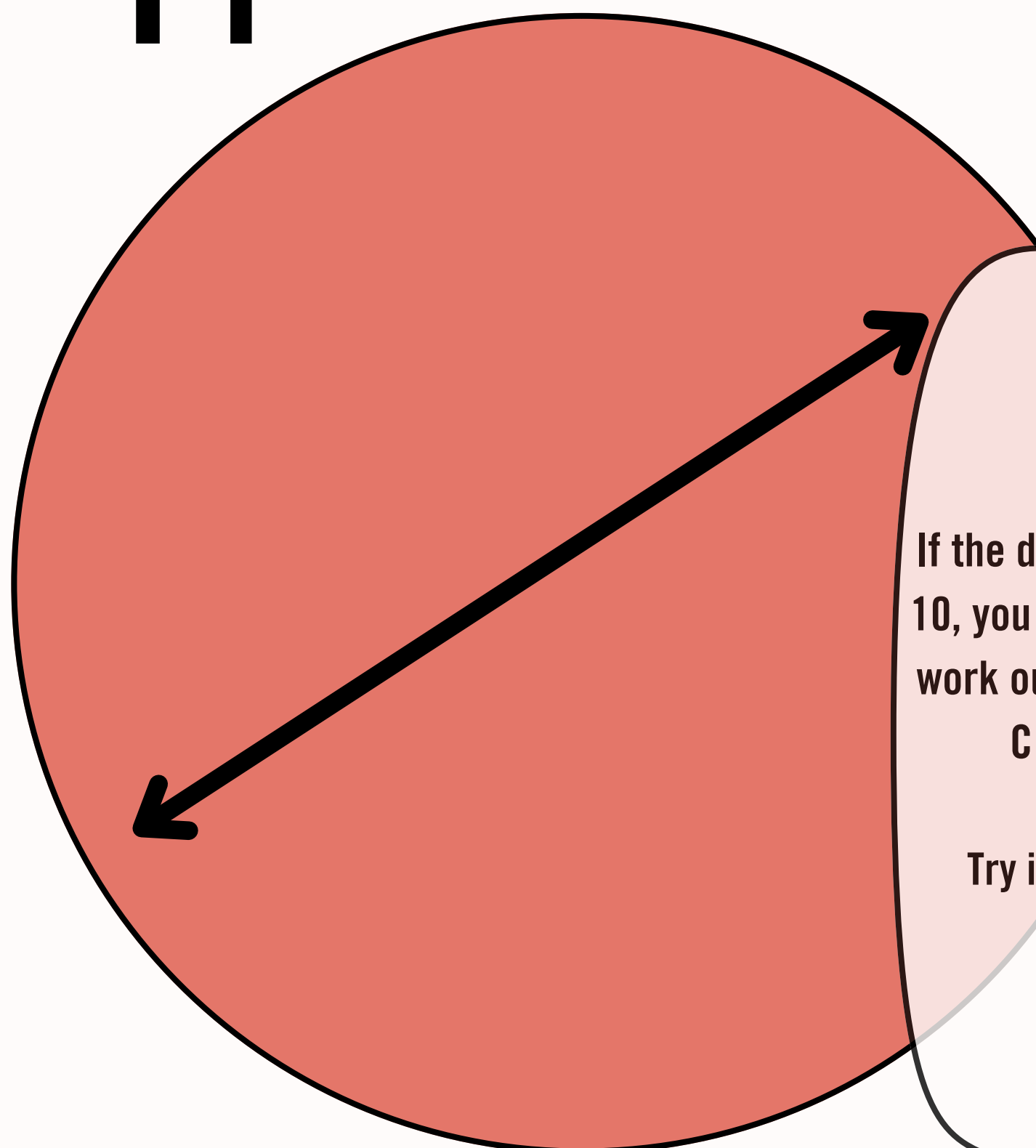
This symbol is Pi

Measure all around a circle (circumference)

Measure through the middle of the circle (diameter)

Circumference \div diameter = π

No matter how big or small a circle is Pi will always be 3.14159...



If the diameter of a circle is 10, you can times 10 by Pi to work out the circumference
 $C = 10 \times 3.14159$
 $C = 31.4159$
Try it with any number!
