decides on a case.

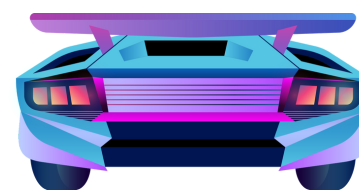
Can also mean 'to

## Knew

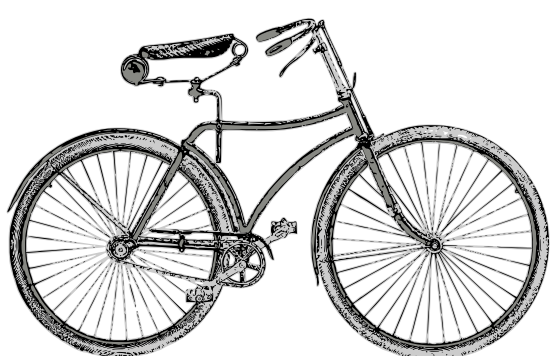
Past tense of know

A  
**PREPOSITION**

(prep-o-zish-un)

is a word that links a noun or  
pronoun to the rest of a sentence.

So a

**PREPOSITION**

is a linking word

Like this ...

"I am going **TO** school"

## Aloud

Saying something loud or clear  
"She said it aloud"



## Allowed

Having (or not having) permission  
"We are not allowed to go in there"



## Buy

When you pay money for items  
"I'm going to buy food at the canteen"
