Our Plan

1. Grow the number of actively engaged volunteers and increase the diversity of backgrounds, skills, and experiences across our volunteer teams

- 1.1 Build partnerships with local organisations and networks to increase recruitment of volunteers local to our partner schools
- 1.2 Implement policies and practices to reduce barriers to volunteering and to ensure Ardoch is a culturally safe space for all volunteers
- 1.3 Innovate with new recruitment methods to increase the number of people volunteering with Ardoch

3. Enhance the impact of our volunteering programs

- 3.1 Enhance our capacity to measure and evaluate volunteer impact
- 3.2 Adapt volunteer programs and volunteer roles to increase the impact that can be created from the connections
- 3.3 More clearly communicate the impact of the volunteer programs

2. Make volunteer roles flexible and responsive to school needs

- 2.1 Implement new approaches to identify and match school needs with volunteer programs or skills
- 2.2 Innovate with different volunteering models to increase flexibility and enable participation of a broader range of potential volunteers
- 2.3 Provide more support and clarity for schools and volunteers to facilitate volunteer induction and ongoing volunteer impact for students

4. Deepen volunteer connection across the organisation

- 4.1 Deepen the involvement and recognition of volunteers at all levels of Ardoch
- 4.2 Create pathways for volunteers to develop and take on greater responsibilities
- 4.3 Increase opportunities for volunteers to connect with other volunteers and programs outside of their direct volunteering
